AVAC USTA Player FAQs

What should I expect when Registration Opens for AVAC teams?

- Members will receive an email with instructions to register, and AVAC website will show registration links, and calendar for League play
- Players should register through provided link, ahead of deadline provided
- Be aware that AVAC player registration is an indication of intent to play, as it is utilized in the process to determines team size and team numbers

What should I expect after I register, but Prior to First Season Matches?

- Players should expect Communication from the Captain as to team basics including expectations of match play based upon "at level" guidelines
- Players should proactively familiarize themselves with USTA "Friend at Court" and current year Local League Area Regulations to foster good match play (both available on USTA NorCal website) https://www.usta.com/en/home/play/adult-tennis/programs/northerncalifornia/tennis-resources.html
- Players should feel comfortable contacting their Captain or USTA Coordinator if there is need for clarity regarding the upcoming Season

What should I expect during the Season of Play?

- Players are strongly encouraged to provide availability for matches, once schedule
 is published on USTA Website, and maintain "up-to-date" availability as schedules
 can change and this is helpful for the Captain's scheduling and the entire team to
 know who is available to play
- Players are encouraged to embrace team aspects of play and be timely with responses and arrivals for practice and matches. Common Courtesy applies here
- Players are encouraged to reference USTA Player Resources if they have specific questions about playing guidelines, and players are welcome to ask for clarity from the Captain or USTA Coordinator if
